Who We Seek to Reach

The ministry serves people navigating difficult life seasons, with particular program attention to Black individuals and families affected by kidney disease; patients and caregivers; family caregivers facing chronic illness, disability, aging, or life-changing medical conditions; students seeking educational opportunity; churches and community organizations; and people seeking accessible biblical and practical resources.

Current Funding Priorities

Partnership helps turn vision into sustainable capacity.

Funding priorities are organized into distinct lanes so foundations, corporations, healthcare organizations, churches, community partners, and individual philanthropists can identify where their interests align.

1. IMPACT Black Kidney Health

Community kidney-health education, early-awareness resources, patient and caregiver support, IMPACT Ambassador development, digital resources, program coordination, evaluation, church/community engagement, and future facility/capital development.

2. Caregiver Support & Education

A developing initiative for family caregivers navigating chronic illness, disability, aging, dementia, dialysis, stroke recovery, and other life-changing conditions. Funding may support education, workshops, digital resources, navigation, and coordination.

3. Education & Scholarships

Support for the separate Ida B. Wells Educational Scholarship Fund and Nicole Washington STILL HERE Scholarship. Awards depend upon available funding and established selection criteria.

4. Community Outreach

Backpack Program, educational and resource distribution, community service projects, volunteer engagement, events, and other approved outreach activities.

5. Digital Ministry & Educational Access

Website infrastructure, digital publishing, accessible teaching and prayer resources, Bible study, Communion, Wisdom Vault resources, video/audio ministry, and resource organization.

6. Future Capacity & Infrastructure

Program administration, technology, evaluation, volunteer development, educational materials, partnerships, and appropriate future physical program space.

IMPACT Black Kidney Health

Know Early. Live Strong. You Are Not Alone.

IMPACT Black Kidney Health is an initiative of Nicole Washington Ministries developing a community-based kidney-health model designed to reach people across the kidney journey - from early awareness through kidney disease, dialysis, transplantation, caregiving, and life beyond diagnosis.

The IMPACT Kidney Journey Model™

BEFORE THE CHAIR Know earlier. Ask earlier. Act earlier. Community education, risk awareness, Know Your Numbers, ASK - TEST - KNOW, and trusted kidney-health resources.	AT THE CHAIR Understand your care. Find your voice. Nonclinical education, patient navigation, self-advocacy tools, caregiver support, and practical guidance for people beginning and living with dialysis.	BEYOND THE CHAIR Understand your options. Keep living. Treatment-option education, transplant navigation, caregiver support, identity, relationships, purpose, and life beyond treatment.
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What Investment Can Help Build

Philanthropic and institutional investment can help develop curriculum, train community Ambassadors and future Kidney Navigators, create patient and caregiver resources, equip churches and community organizations, build digital tools, measure outcomes, and develop the infrastructure needed to carry the model into more communities.

Program Integrity

IMPACT provides education, support, advocacy, and resource navigation. It does not provide medical diagnosis, individualized treatment recommendations, or replace care from qualified healthcare professionals. Future facility development is presented as a development priority; confidential property and location information are not included.

Capacity, Accountability & Evidence

The story of impact should be documented, not invented.

Nicole Washington Ministries is building its next phase with a commitment to accurate reporting. As funded programming expands, evaluation will be appropriate to each program and to the scope of funded work.

What We Intend to Measure

Our Work in Action

The ministry's public evidence framework is designed to grow from verified activity: authentic community outreach, dialysis-community engagement, educational resources already created, speaking and community engagement, and future program results documented after activities actually occur.

A Developing Funding Story

Nicole Washington Ministries has historically been founder-supported and has not built its public identity around outside fundraising. The current funding strategy is intentionally transparent: clearly defined programs, measurable objectives, responsible development language, and partnerships built around work that can be documented.

Specific objectives and annual targets will be established according to funded program scope and available resources.
