

✓Hearing Aid Decision Checklist

8 things to clarify before you commit

Bring this with you before a clinic visit, or use it after a quote. The goal is simple: slow the decision down before you spend thousands.

Checklist questions

☐ 1

Can I get a copy of my hearing test?

Ask for the full results and make sure you understand what they mean for each ear.

☐ 2

What type and degree of hearing loss do I have?

Clarify whether the severity of the loss or if it is different from one ear to the other.

☐ 3

What exact model, style, and technology level is recommended?

Ask why that option fits your hearing needs, lifestyle, comfort, and budget.

☐ 4

Are there other reasonable options I should compare?

Ask what you gain or give up by changing technology level, brand, style, or care model.

☐ 5

What is the full out-the-door cost?

Confirm devices, fitting, programming, charger, app help, supplies, warranty, and service terms.

☐ 6

What does my insurance actually cover?

Ask if it is true coverage, a discount program, reimbursement, or mostly out-of-pocket.

☐ 7

What follow-up care is included after the fitting?

Ask who handles adjustments, how quickly help is available, and whether remote care is offered.

☐ 8

Does this choice fit my real listening life?

Ask about work, restaurants, church, family gatherings, TV, phone calls,, Bluetooth, tinnitus, and physical comfort.
